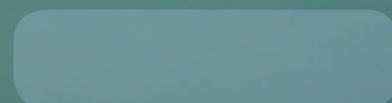
The festival will also discuss the complexity of mankind living beside and within the natural world and what WE can do to help preserve it. It is our job to provide nature with a better and safer future.
